

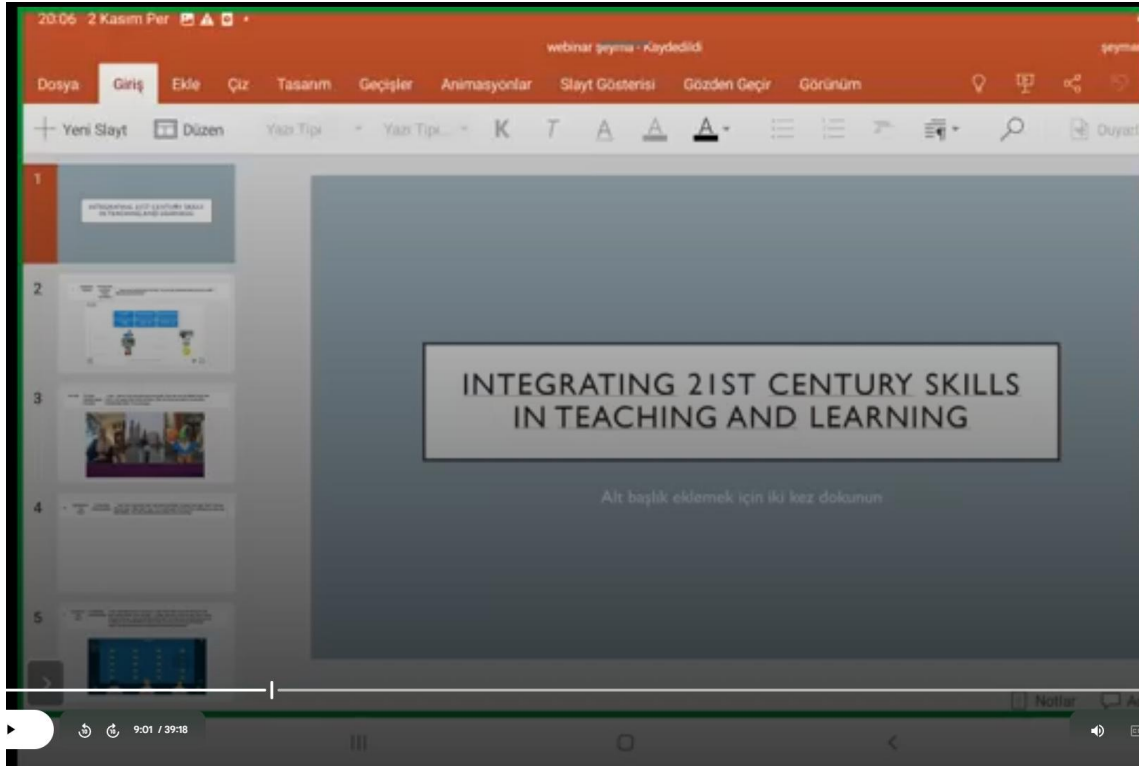
**International Collaboration for Pre-service English Teachers:
University of Pristina, Kosovo & Eskişehir Osmangazi University**

During the Fall Semester of the 2023–2024 academic year, the Department of English Language Teaching at Faculty of Education, Eskişehir Osmangazi University, organized a series of weekly webinars in collaboration with the Department of English Language and Literature at the Faculty of Philology, University of Pristina, Kosovo. These webinars, held for two hours each week, focused on the exchange of theoretical knowledge and professional experiences.

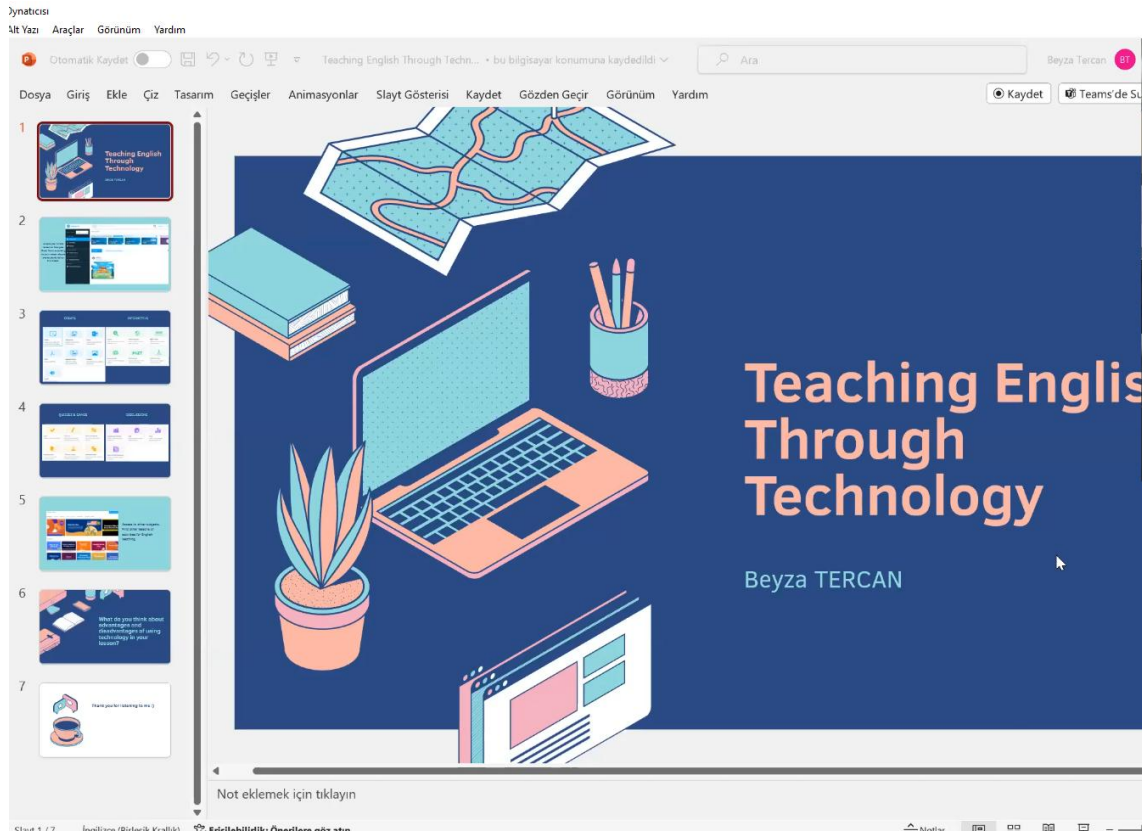
With the aim of strengthening Erasmus relations and encouraging students to engage in international collaboration, the webinar series was led by Dr. Blerta Mustafa, Dr. Lindita Rugova, and Dr. Yllka Pacarizi from the University of Pristina, and Assoc. The primary goal of these meetings was to provide a platform for pre-service teachers from both universities not only to exchange theoretical knowledge but also to engage in practice-oriented discussions and share their field experiences. Additionally, the webinars aimed to foster dialogue and idea exchange regarding English language teaching in different educational contexts.

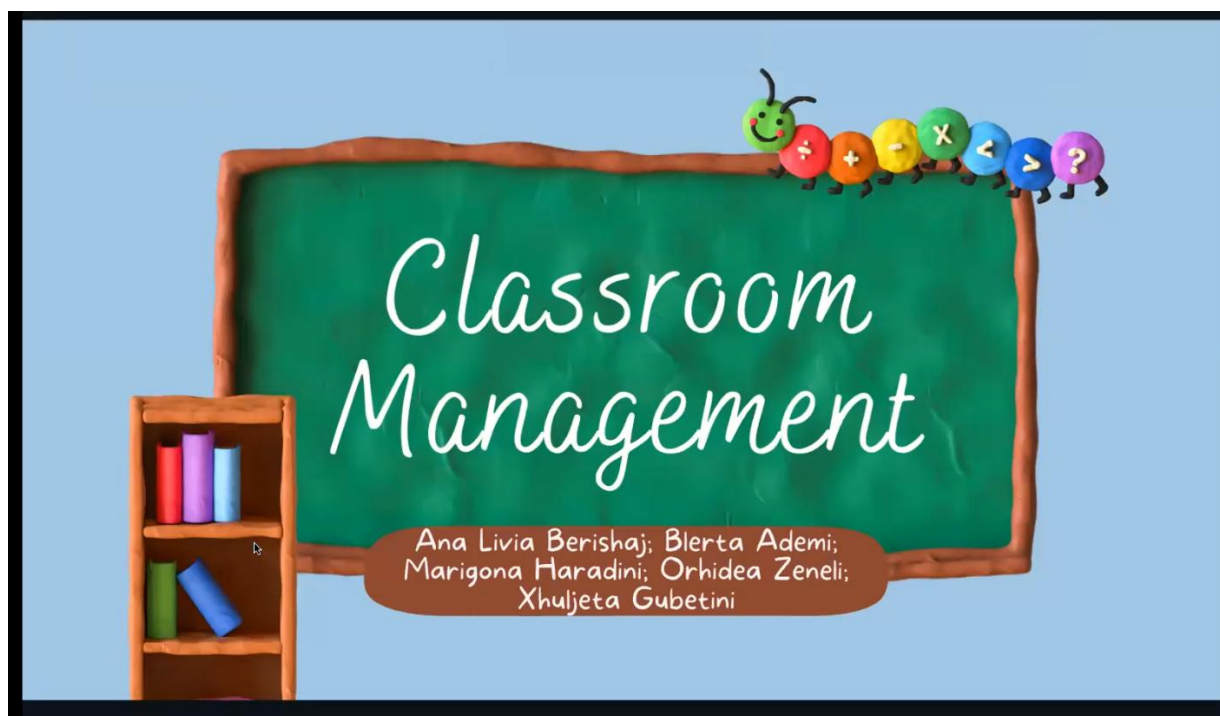

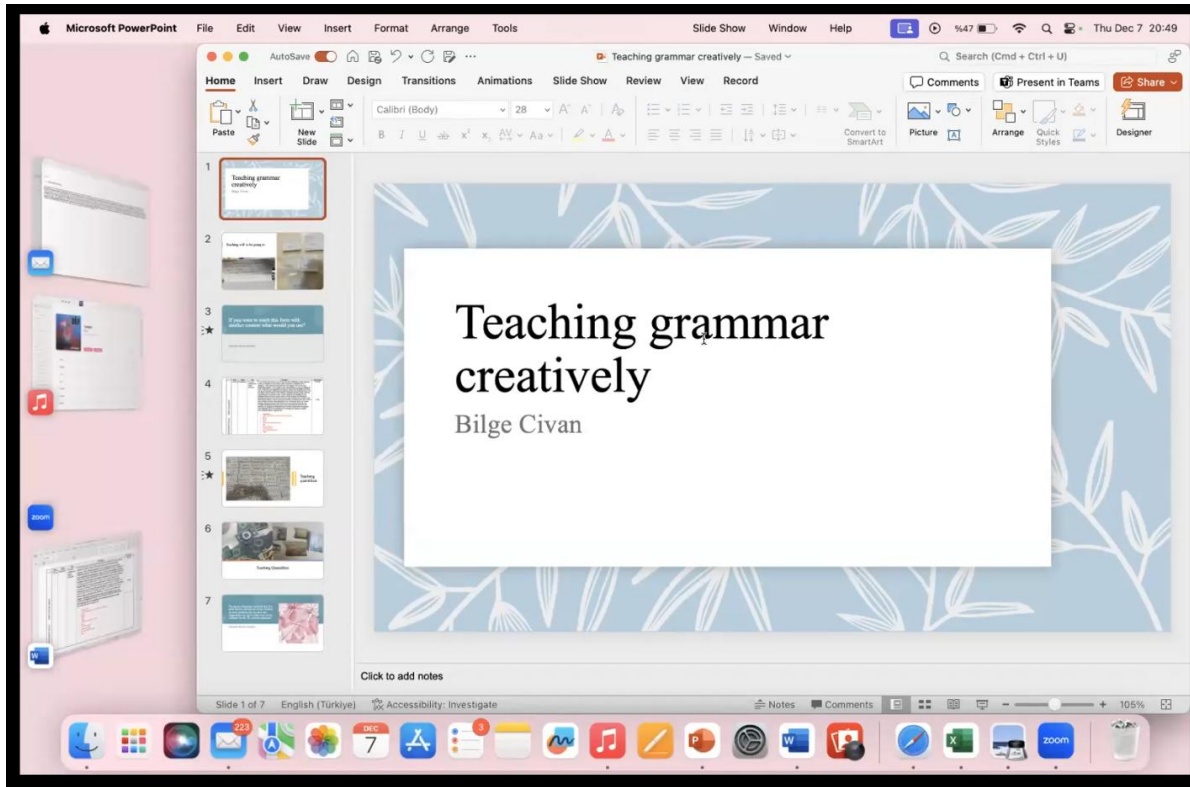
